

Type of procedure	Endovascular aneurysm repair (EVAR)
Airway	Intubation or sedation depending on approach and patient
Anesthesia model	General anesthesia or local anesthesia with sedation
Epi / Spinal	–
Premedication	Paracetamol ± Ondansetron
Notes	Risk of bleeding, contrast nephropathy, and hemodynamic instability. Maintain normothermia and stable blood pressure.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV x2 ($\geq 18G$). Arterial line recommended. Consider central venous access in high-risk patients.
