

Type of procedure	Epiglottitis
Airway	Usually awake nasal fiberoptic intubation
Anesthesia model	Sevoflurane / Fentanyl
Epi / Spinal	–
Premedication	Premedication given intravenously in the operating room
Notes	Secure airway early. High risk of rapid airway obstruction. ENT surgeon and difficult airway equipment must be immediately available.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV x2 (18–20G). Arterial line if ASA \geq 3 or prolonged procedure.
