

Type of procedure	Head and neck surgery
Airway	Shared airway. Endotracheal or tracheostomy tube.
Anesthesia model	General anesthesia: TIVA or Sevoflurane / Remifentanyl.
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Betamethasone ± Paracetamol / NSAID.
Postoperative analgesia	Multimodal analgesia. IV opioids often required.
Notes	Major surgery with significant airway risk. Plan airway strategy together with surgeon. Postoperative airway edema common. Consider elective tracheostomy and ICU care.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×2 (18–16G). Arterial line recommended. CVK as needed.
