

Type of procedure	Hemimaxillectomy, hemimandibulectomy and neck dissection
Airway	Nasal intubation.
Anesthesia model	Inhalational anesthesia with Sevoflurane / Remifentanil
Epi / Spinal	–
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Betamethasone ± Paracetamol / COX inhibitor
Postoperative analgesia	Local anesthesia ± IV oxycodone. Pediatric patients may also receive Betamethasone, Clonidine, Dynastat and Paracetamol.
Notes	Secure nasal tube and protect airway from blood. Anticipate prolonged surgery and significant blood loss. Consider postoperative airway swelling and ICU need. Close communication with surgeon.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×2 (18–20G). Arterial line recommended for long procedures or ASA ≥ 3.
