

Type of procedure	Hidradenitis suppurativa surgery
Airway	LMA or endotracheal intubation depending on extent and position.
Anesthesia model	General anesthesia ± regional techniques.
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Dexamethasone ± Paracetamol / NSAID.
Postoperative analgesia	Multimodal analgesia. Opioids often required.
Notes	Often extensive excisions with significant postoperative pain. Multiple surgical fields common (axilla, groin, perineum). Consider regional blocks and wound infiltration. Plan for repeated procedures and chronic pain management.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×1–2. Arterial line rarely required.
