

<b>Type of procedure</b>	<b>Lymph node excision</b>
<b>Airway</b>	Endotracheal intubation or LMA depending on site.
<b>Anesthesia model</b>	General anesthesia or TIVA.
<b>Premedication</b>	Ondansetron ± Betamethasone ± Paracetamol / COX inhibitor.
<b>Postoperative analgesia</b>	Paracetamol ± IV oxycodone if needed.
<b>Notes</b>	Usually a short procedure. Risk of bleeding depending on location. Consider nerve proximity in cervical procedures.
<b>Recommended vascular access</b>	Peripheral IV ×1–2 (18–20G).
