

Type of procedure	Mandibular fracture
Airway	Endotracheal intubation. Anticipate difficult airway.
Anesthesia model	General anesthesia: Sevoflurane / Remifentanil.
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Betamethasone ± Paracetamol / COX inhibitor.
Postoperative analgesia	Clonidine and oxycodone.
Notes	<p>Risk of bleeding and airway compromise.</p> <p>Limited mouth opening may complicate airway management.</p> <p>Plan extubation carefully.</p>
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×2 (18–20G). Consider arterial line if ASA ≥ 3 or prolonged surgery.
