

Type of procedure	Nasal reposition – acute / on-call
Airway	Mask anesthesia or endotracheal intubation depending on fracture and bleeding.
Anesthesia model	Short general anesthesia: Propofol / Alfentanil.
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Paracetamol.
Postoperative analgesia	Paracetamol ± opioids if needed.
Notes	Often urgent procedure, potentially painful. Assess bleeding and aspiration risk. Be prepared to secure airway if bleeding increases.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×1–2 (18–20G).
