

Type of procedure	Palatal lipofilling (cleft-related)
Airway	Endotracheal intubation. Shared airway.
Anesthesia model	General anesthesia: Sevoflurane or TIVA.
Premedication	Paracetamol ± Ondansetron.
Postoperative analgesia	Paracetamol ± NSAID. Opioids rarely required.
Notes	<p>Pediatric plastic surgery related to cleft palate management. Shared airway with blood and fat grafting in oral cavity. Protect airway carefully and consider throat pack. Aspiration risk – thorough suction before extubation.</p>
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×1–2 (22–20G).
