

Type of procedure	Parotidectomy
Airway	Endotracheal intubation.
Anesthesia model	TIVA: Propofol / Remifentanil.
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Betamethasone ± Paracetamol / COX inhibitor.
Postoperative analgesia	Multimodal analgesia ± IV opioids.
Notes	Major head and neck surgery with risk to facial nerve. Avoid neuromuscular blockade if nerve monitoring is used. Risk of postoperative bleeding and airway compromise. Consider postoperative high-dependency or ICU care.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×2 (≥18G). Consider arterial line for prolonged surgery.
