

Type of procedure	Radical neck dissection
Airway	Endotracheal intubation. Anticipate difficult airway and postoperative edema.
Anesthesia model	TIVA: Propofol / Remifentanyl.
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Betamethasone ± Paracetamol / COX inhibitor.
Postoperative analgesia	Multimodal analgesia ± IV opioids.
Notes	Major head and neck oncologic surgery. High risk of bleeding and postoperative airway compromise. Consider delayed extubation and planned ICU admission. Close communication with surgical team.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×2 (≥16–18G). Arterial line recommended. Prepare blood products.
