

Type of procedure	TOUSS – Transoral Ultrasonic Surgery
Airway	Nasal endotracheal intubation. Shared airway.
Anesthesia model	TIVA: Propofol / Remifentanil.
Premedication	Ondansetron ± Betamethasone ± Paracetamol / COX inhibitor.
Postoperative analgesia	Paracetamol ± IV opioids if required.
Notes	<p>Transoral head and neck surgery with shared airway. Prepare nasal mucosa with vasoconstrictor and local anesthetic. Assess bleeding risk and airway edema postoperatively. Close coordination with surgeon essential.</p>
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×2 (18–20G). Consider arterial line if extensive surgery.
