

<b>Type of procedure</b>	<b>Unicoronal synostosis (~6 months)</b>
<b>Airway</b>	Endotracheal intubation.
<b>Anesthesia model</b>	General anesthesia: Sevoflurane/Fentanyl or TIVA.
<b>Premedication</b>	EMLA (age/weight adjusted). Clonidine PO if >1–2 years.
<b>Postoperative analgesia</b>	Clonidine and morphine. NSAID if appropriate.
<b>Notes</b>	Major craniofacial surgery in infants. High risk of blood loss – meticulous fluid and Hb management. Temperature control critical. Postoperative monitoring in ICU/HDU often required.
<b>Recommended vascular access</b>	Peripheral IV x2 (20–22G) + arterial line. CVK often motivated.
