

Type of procedure	Amputations
Airway	Laryngeal mask airway
Anesthesia model	Fentanyl / Sevoflurane
Epi / Spinal	Usually spinal anesthesia; alternatively Epi + general anesthesia
Ketamine infusion	–
Premedication	Paracetamol + COX inhibitor + Oxycodone
Tips for the anesthesiologist	Adapt monitoring to procedure type. Consider positioning, pain management, and PONV prophylaxis.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×1–2 (18–20G). Arterial line considered for major procedures or ASA ≥3.
