

Type of procedure	Femur fracture
Airway	Preferably spontaneous breathing; intubation if required
Anesthesia model	Sevoflurane / Fentanyl if GA
Epi / Spinal	Femoral or FIC block followed by spinal anesthesia
Ketamine infusion	–
Premedication	Paracetamol
Tips for the anesthesiologist	Longer operative time; bleeding risk. Positioning, fluid balance and postoperative analgesia are important.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV x2 ($\geq 18G$). Arterial line if ASA ≥ 3 or bleeding risk.
