

Type of procedure	Lower extremity surgery
Airway	Depends on procedure
Regional anesthesia	Peripheral nerve block when appropriate
Anesthesia maintenance	Fentanyl + Sevoflurane or TIVA
Epi / Spinal	Spinal or Epi when appropriate
Premedication	According to procedure
Tips for the anesthesiologist	Adapt monitoring to procedure type. Consider positioning, pain management and PONV prophylaxis.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×1–2 (18–20G). Arterial line if major procedure or ASA ≥3.
