

Type of procedure	Usually SpEDA alternatively general anesthesia with intubation. Spinal anesthesia alone may be sufficient for minor procedures.
Airway	Depends on anesthesia technique
Block	—
Anesthesia maintenance	According to chosen technique
Epi / Spinal	Spinal alone for minor procedures
Ketamine infusion	—
Premedication	—
Tips for the anesthesiologist	Adapt monitoring to procedure type. Consider positioning, pain control and PONV prophylaxis.
Recommended vascular access	Peripheral IV ×1–2 (18–20G). Consider arterial line for major procedures or ASA ≥3.
