

Type of Procedure	In fractures of the tibia there is a risk of compartment syndrome. Regional anaesthesia can be used, taking special account of this risk.

Tips for the anaesthesiologist	Adapt monitoring after the type of surgery. Consider positioning, pain management and PONV prophylaxis.
Recommended vascular access	1–2 peripheral IV cannulas (18–20G). Arterial line monitoring should be considered in major surgery or ASA ≥3.
