

Type of Procedure	Postpartum Haemorrhage
Airway	GA. General anaesthesia as a backup.
Anaesthetic technique	Propofol/Sevo
Epidural/Spinal	Spinal Marcaine Heavy 6–7 mg + 10 µg Fentanyl
Premedication*	
Short tips for the anaesthetist	Spinal level: from dermatome T4 and below – or higher, depending on the situation. Top-Up EDA: local anaesthetic + opioid, e.g. both short- and long-acting. EDA: Local vasoconstrictor + opioid, e.g. both short- and long-acting.
Recommended vascular access	1–2 peripheral IV cannulas depending on the extent of the procedure. Adapt according to the anticipated risk of bleeding.
